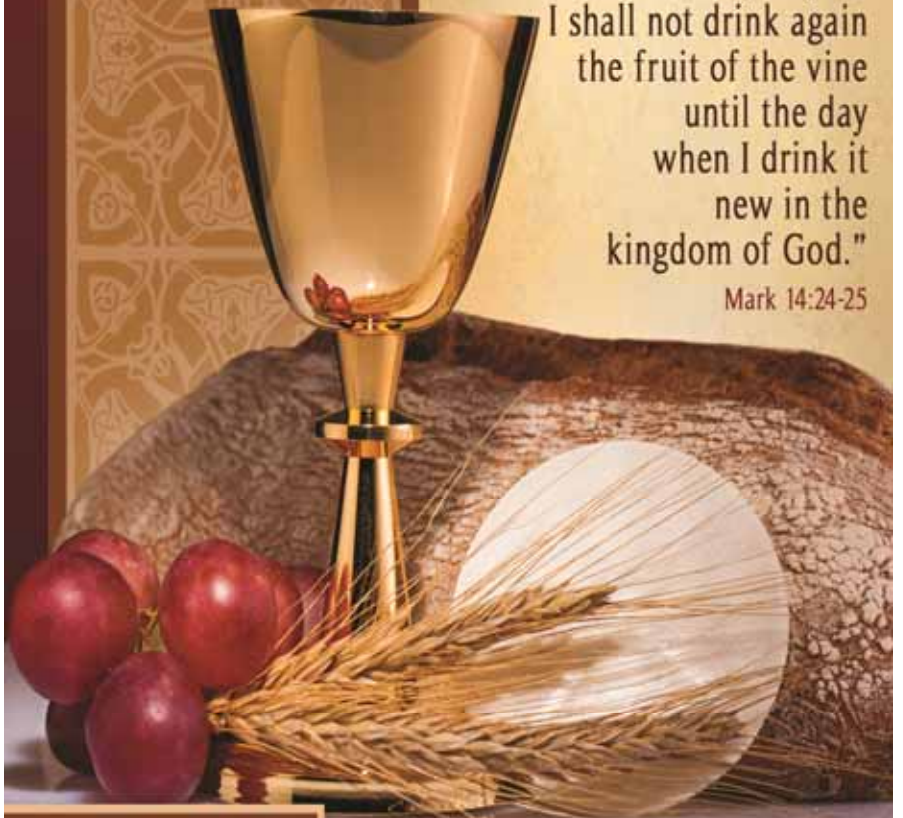

From the Pastor's Desk

*“How shall I make a return to the Lord for all the good he has done for me?
The cup of salvation I will take up, and I will call upon the name of the Lord.”*

(Psalm 116:12-13)

This Sunday we celebrate the **Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**. The Eucharist, the moment in the Mass when we re-present Christ's sacrifice and offer him to God the Father, is the source and summit of our faith. This once-for-all sacrifice is always pleasing to the Father and reconciles us to God through Jesus Christ. In his sacrifice for us, Christ saves us.

In a mysterious and miraculous way, Christ wholly and physically reappears to us through the elements of bread and wine, which become his Body and Blood during the Eucharistic Prayer. In taking the Body and Blood of Christ into our bodies, we physically and spiritually unite ourselves with Christ.

At the same time as we are joined in communion with Christ through his Body and Blood, all those who are also consuming his Body and Blood are joined together in Christ, as well. All who have a proper disposition and formation and who consume the Eucharist literally join themselves to Christ's Body (and Blood) in heaven and Christ literally joins himself to their bodies on earth.

Given Christ's physical presence among us in the Eucharist, it is easy to understand that the Body and Blood of Christ act as the source and summit of our faith. Jesus Christ is the food and drink of eternal life that nourishes, heals, and fulfills us.

As always, but today in a special way, we rejoice and celebrate in thanksgiving over Christ's wondrous gift of himself to us. His Body and Blood renew us, transform us, and lead us to everlasting life.

As we gather to share in Christ's Body and Blood today, we recognize that we have been doing so as a community for the last 50 years. We are grateful for this blessing and we pray that we might continue to be blessed in a similar way far into the future.

As I mentioned in last week's bulletin, we are making plans to celebrate our 50th Anniversary in several ways. Among these are a **special Mass celebrated by Cardinal Cupich on Sunday, August 5th, at 11am**, followed by a light reception in Shea Hall.

In addition, there will be an opportunity for parishioners to attend a **kick-off dinner** at a banquet hall outside the parish in honor of our 50 years as a parish community. This event will require parishioners to purchase tickets ahead of time.

As both a memento of our 50 years as a parish and as an informative tool for promoting community, the Parish is organizing a **St. Julian Eymard 50th Anniversary Parish Directory**. **Please schedule an appointment** with our photographers for a professional portrait of your family. The photographers will only be on-site and taking pictures for a limited time during July and early August. The Parish hopes to have the directories ready for our 50th Anniversary celebration in September, which is the reason for having the portraits done by early August.

Please watch for emails and phone calls from the Parish and from Lifetouch, the directory publishers, about scheduling an appointment. In this early stage of the process, the Parish Anniversary Committee will also be placing people in the vestibule following Masses to help parishioners sign up for family portraits. The greater number of parishioners who participate in the directory, the more useful and valuable the directory will be for everyone. **Please schedule an appointment to have your family's portrait taken!**

In addition to the events mentioned, our Parish's principal event to celebrate 50 years will be a

Fiftieth Anniversary Family Festival on Sunday, September 16th. It will be free to all parishioners and their guests. It will also have activities for the entire family. **The Parish is asking parishioners to donate items for auction, prizes, and raffles. If you have unused airline miles, professional sports tickets, vacation home time to offer, or other attractive or valuable items or services, please contact the Parish Office.**

Also mentioned last week, **the Parish is now offering On-line Giving** - a feature that provides each parishioner with the opportunity to contribute to the Parish through the internet. This is a convenient and safe way to ensure that the Parish receives your contributions on a timely basis. **On-line Giving helps parishioners to better regulate their contributions without the need to personally deliver or mail their contributions to the Parish.**

To begin the process, please go to our website at www.stjulianeynard.org. Find the **“Our Parish”** section (the title heading for the last of the four green-colored boxes in the middle of the page – after the boxes entitled “PPC,” “Our Faith,” and “Parish Events”) and locate **“Parish On-Line Giving.”** at the bottom of the list, under the “Our Parish” section. Click on this last option to be connected to the on-line giving menu.

You may have noticed **two large potholes near the church building** on your way through the parking lot that lets out onto Leicester Street. This section of the parking lot is leased to the Elk Grove Village Park District who, as part of its lease, is responsible for maintaining this section of the lot. **The Park District is planning to repair the potholes in the fall, at which time it plans to re-surface its leased section of our parking lot.** Until then, please slow down before going over the potholes or drive around them.

This week the Parish has come to an arrangement with **Sebert Lawn and Snow Services**. This is a trial arrangement that allows Sebert employees to park their personal vehicles in the western most area of our parking lot. The employees may park there on weekdays from 6am to 3pm during the winter and from 6am to 8pm during the summer, unless the Parish has a need for the lot during those times.

In exchange for parking for its employees, Sebert Lawn and Snow Services will provide the Parish with both lawn care and snow removal along with surface salting at no charge. In addition, it will repair the collapsed pipe in that western section of the parking lot that has allowed water to collect into a pool and resulted in our local geese using the pool as a recreational floating pond.

The Parish was the victim of a theft of her candle collection and candle collection cabinet. The theft likely occurred on the night of Tuesday, May 22nd. Some person or persons entered our Parish vestibule and removed the entire candle collection cabinet, which contained a strong box as part of its construction. Although the donations in the strong box had been removed the day before, the cabinet itself was worth about \$800.

A police report was made of the incident. In addition, serious consideration is being given to installing more security in and around the Parish building, especially in light of the many violent incidents taking place throughout the country. In any event, **parishioners are urged to check that doors are locked and secured when they leave the building at the end of an event.**

In the meantime, we pray that those who took the candle donations and cabinet might have a strong need for the money and might be moved to repent for their misdeed by surrendering themselves to the police and amending their lives to the good.

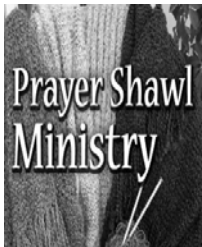
